

bus service changes

march 2015



This leaflet has been produced by Lancashire County Council. It is issued at the beginning of each month to help you keep up-to-date with changes made to bus services in the county.

Changes to Bus Services – March 2015

Service

LANCASTER SERVICES

555 Lancaster - Carnforth - Kendal - Keswick (STC leaflet)

From **28 March 2015** Stagecoach in Cumbria will revise the route and timetable, adjusting the route, to standardise all journeys direct along A6 and A6070, withdrawing the diversion of those Monday to Saturday journeys through Borwick and Priest Hutton:

0700, 0845 & 1200 from Kendal to Lancaster;
1320, 1630 & 1730 from Lancaster to Kendal.

There will also be some other time adjustments to a number of journeys to improve overall reliability for the 2015 summer season.

755 Heysham - Morecambe - Carnforth - Kendal - Windermere - Bowness (STL leaflet)

From **28 March 2015** Stagecoach in Lancaster will revise the route and timetable for the 2015 summer season, adjusting the service to commence from Heysham, removing the section from Lancaster University.

PRESTON SERVICES

4/4A Preston - Fulwood - Whittingham - Longridge (STG leaflet)

From **2 March 2015** Stagecoach in Lancashire will revise the timetable, adjusting the times of the 1552 Monday to Friday journey from Longridge to Preston to improve reliability.

150/151 Preston - Gregson Lane - Bamber Bridge (STG leaflet)

From **2 March 2015** Stagecoach in Lancashire will revise the route and timetable, adjusting the route in Gregson Lane to operate direct via Alma Row to Daub Hall Lane, no longer serving Alder Drive. Customers from Alder Drive will be required to use bus stops on Alma Row or Daub Hall Lane to access the service.

WEST LANCASHIRE SERVICES

300 Liverpool - Bootle - Halsall - Southport (Merseytravel leaflet)

From **29 March 2015** Arriva North West will revise the route and timetable, adjusting the route in Southport, the terminus will be revised to Union Street and

rerouted to serve more of the town centre. The times will be adjusted throughout to improve service reliability.

375/385 Wigan - Skelmersdale - Ormskirk - Southport (ARV leaflet)

From **29 March 2015** Arriva North West will revise the route and timetable, adjusting the route in Southport to no longer serve Kew Lane, in front of Southport & District Hospital. Bus customers accessing the hospital will be required to use the side access road off Scarisbrick New Road. The times will be adjusted throughout to improve service reliability.

BURNLEY & PENDLE SERVICES

1/1A/1B/1C Stoops Estate - Bleak House - Burnley Bus Station - Brownhill (1A) - Pike Hill - Worsthorne (1) (BPT leaflet)

From **1 March 2015** Transdev Burnley and Pendle will revise the route and timetable. The revised Service 1/1A will continue to operate every 15 minutes (Monday to Saturday daytime) between Stoops and Pike Hill Brunshaw

Road with alternate journeys operating via Rimington Avenue and extending to Worsthorne (Service 1) or via Brownhill Drive and Brunshaw Avenue Shops (Service 1A). All services towards Burnley town centre will depart from Brunshaw Road stops on the Tesco side of the road.

In Burnley town centre Services 1 and 1A will be diverted to serve St James Street, rather than Manchester Road at the Mechanics, thereby offering new links to this part of the town centre and closer links to Burnley College. Some early Saturday morning journeys will continue to operate via the Mechanics as will the evening and Sunday service.

Evening & Sunday route and timetable remain unchanged with the exception of the Worsthorne service being renumbered as Service 1 rather than 1A.

2 Burnley - Queen Victoria Road - Burnley General - Waidshouse Road - Nelson - Higherford (BPT leaflet)

From **1 March 2015** Transdev Burnley and Pendle will revise the route and timetable. The service will be rerouted within Nelson to

serve the Morrisons supermarket. Evening and Sunday journeys will continue to operate direct via Scotland Road omitting Morrisons.

The service will continue to operate every 30 minutes (every hour evening and Sundays).

The service between Burnley Bus Station and Worsthorne is replaced by revised Service 1A.

**4 Rosegrove - Sycamore Drive
- Westgate - Burnley BS -
Burnley General - Harle Syke -
Nelson - Boundary Mill**

**5 Rosegrove - Accrington Road
- Trafalgar Street - Burnley BS -
Burnley General - Harle Syke
(BPT leaflet)**

From 1 March 2015 Transdev Burnley and Pendle will revise the route and timetable. The existing service levels will be maintained but how the services operate will change. Buses via Sycamore Avenue will now be a Service 4 regardless of which direction they are travelling, likewise all journeys via Accrington Road will show Service 5. Passengers can continue to board as now and travel beyond the Rosegrove terminus (so board a Service 4 at Sycamore Avenue then stay on

board when the bus becomes a Service 5 at Rosegrove and travel on to Burnley town centre).

Service 5 will also be rerouted within the town centre to serve Trafalgar Street, the new University Technical College, Manchester Road station and Burnley Mechanics. Service 4 will continue to serve Westgate and St James's Street (as will Service 9 offering continued connections between Accrington Road and these stops). Evening and Sunday journeys will continue to serve Westgate not Trafalgar Street at the existing times.

Some journeys on service 4 will extend beyond Harle Syke to serve Hibson Road, Nelson Interchange, Marsden Park, Colne Asda and Boundary Mill on an approximately hourly service during the off peak and weekends, including Sundays. These journeys will not serve the turning circle at Harle Syke.

These are the changes for March 2015 that have been reported to Lancashire County Council by 09 February 2015. Every effort has been made to ensure the accuracy of this information, however further changes can occur, it is advisable to contact your local County Information Centre, Traveline or bus operator for the latest information.
