<p>Service</p> <p>RIBBLE VALLEY SERVICES</p> <p>22 Clitheroe – Whalley – Blackburn (LUL leaflet)</p> <p>From 28 August 2016 Transdev Lancashire United will revise the timetable, adjusting Monday to Friday peak journey times to improve overall service reliability.</p> <p>WYRE & FYLDE SERVICES</p> <p>Blackpool Transport Services</p> <p>From 3 September 2016 Blackpool Transport will revise all their Saturday service timetables, adjusting journeys to ensure reliability during the illuminations.</p> <p>74 Blackpool – Victoria Hospital – Poulton – Thornton – Fleetwood (Leaflet 186)</p> <p>From 5 September 2016 Lancashire County Council will revise the route and timetable to operate in conjunction with Service 75 between Poulton and Fleetwood.</p> <p>The service will continue to run every hour in each direction on a Monday to Saturday daytime basis between Blackpool and Poulton and combined with Service 75, maintain an hourly service between Poulton and Fleetwood.</p> <p>Rotala Preston Bus will continue to operate this service on behalf of Lancashire County Council.</p>	<p>Service</p> <p>75 Preston – Kirkham – Poulton – Thornton – Fleetwood (Leaflet 186)</p> <p>From 5 September 2016 Lancashire County Council will revise the route and timetable, extending the route to operate through to Fleetwood, incorporating part of Service 74 between Fleetwood and Poulton.</p> <p>The service will continue to run every two hours in each direction on a Monday to Saturday daytime basis between Preston and Fleetwood and combined with Service 74, maintain an hourly service between Poulton and Fleetwood.</p> <p>Although it is not possible to meet everyone's requirements within the limited funding available, one of the significant requests has been for the restoration of the direct link between Fleetwood and Preston. This has affected all types of passenger journeys, for employment, education, medical and leisure. These revisions will restore the direct service between Preston and Fleetwood whilst maintaining full connections at Poulton for through journeys to Blackpool and Victoria Hospital from both north and south within existing resources.</p> <p>All areas will retain the current level of service, although revised times will be necessary. The section of route around Broadwater will no longer</p>	<p>Service</p> <p>be served, however since the reintroduction of access to the Tram for Wyre Concessionary Passholders, passenger numbers on Service 74 have dramatically dropped in the Broadwater area. Alternative more frequent services are also available on Fleetwood Road.</p> <p>Rotala Preston Bus will continue to operate this service on behalf of Lancashire County Council.</p> <p>80 Preston – Great Eccleston – Myerscough (Leaflet 186)</p> <p>From 5 September 2016 Lancashire County Council will revise the timetable, making minor timing adjustments to maintain combined frequency with Service 75 between Preston City Centre and Riversway.</p> <p>Rotala Preston Bus will continue to operate this service on behalf of Lancashire County Council.</p> <p>PRESTON SERVICES</p> <p>4C Preston – Preston College – RPH – Broughton – Longridge (STG leaflet)</p> <p>From 4 September 2016 Stagecoach in Lancashire will revise the route and timetable, introducing additional Monday to Friday daytime journeys between Preston City Centre and</p>	<p>Service</p> <p>Royal Preston Hospital. Leyland. This route adjustment will replace the withdrawal of the temporary shuttle bus Service 109B. Most journey times have been revised to improve overall service reliability.

This will provide a daily link from Cuerden and Clayton-le-Woods with Preston, Leyland and Chorley. This is provided in partnership with Lancashire County Council with funding received from the new housing developments in that area.

109B Leyland – Clayton-le-Woods Shuttle (STG leaflet)

From 4 September 2016 Stagecoach in Lancashire will withdraw this temporary shuttle service, it will be replaced by the revised route on Service 109.

111 Preston – Leyland – Moss Side (STG leaflet)

From 4 September 2016 Stagecoach in Lancashire will revise the route and timetable, revising all journeys to terminate at Moss Side, and no longer serving Earnshaw Bridge Leyland Lane, which will be served by the revised Service 113. Most journey times have been revised to improve overall service reliability.

113 Preston – Leyland – Wigan (STG leaflet)

From 5 September 2016 Stagecoach in Lancashire will revise the route and timetable, adjusting the service in Leyland to additionally serve Broadfield Drive and Earnshaw Bridge Leyland Lane, partially replacing the withdrawn Service 111 from this area.

CHORLEY SERVICES

24 Chorley – Brinscall – Abbey Village – Blackburn (LUL leaflet)

From 28 August 2016 Transdev Lancashire United will revise the timetable, adjusting Monday to Friday peak journey times to improve overall service reliability.

351/361 Chorley – Coppull – Wigan (TfGM leaflet)

From 28 August 2016 Wigan Coachways will revise the timetable, adjusting the times of all journeys to operate 15 minutes later throughout. Also the revised Service 361 Tuesday and Friday journeys at 1035 (from Wigan to Chorley) and 1118 (from Chorley to Wigan) will additionally operate on Monday, Wednesday & Thursday on college days.

From 28 August 2016 Transdev Lancashire United will revise the timetable, introducing minor adjustments to journey times to improve overall service reliability.

From 4 September 2016 Rosso will revise the timetable, making minor adjustments to the times for the start of the new academic year.

484 Accrington – Haslingden – Edenfield – Bury (TfGM leaflet)

From 4 September 2016 Rosso will revise the route and timetable, making minor adjustments to the times for the start of the new academic year and reinstating the normal route in Ramsbottom following the ending of the roadworks.

X35 Walmersley – Edenfield – Manchester (TfGM leaflet)

From 4 September 2016 First Manchester will withdraw all the journeys on this service.
